RULES AND REGULATIONS

Camp St. Volodymyr will begin its program on Sunday August 22nd with a Divine Liturgy at 5 p.m. The program will end on Sunday, August 29th with a closing Divine Liturgy at 7:30 a.m. and a Camp cleanup to follow. Parents are welcome to attend either or both of these Divine Liturgies if they wish, as there will be **no other opportunities for parental visits** at this Camp.

All children staying at Camp St. Volodymyr are subject to its regulations and directives of the Camp Directors, who reserve the right to dismiss any Camper if, in their judgment, such action is warranted.

No Camper shall be permitted to leave camp or return home before the completion of the Camp. Should there be a need for a Camper to leave the Camp for some valid reason, please fill in and sign the consent form provided below.

In the event of a serious illness, the Parent/ Guardian of the camper will be promptly notified. If a Parent/Guardian cannot be reached, consent is hereby given to provide such medical, surgical or dental treatment as may be necessary.

Except for ordinary infirmary care, which is provided free of charge, all medical, surgical or dental expenses incurred by the Camper shall be borne by the Parent/Guardian.

The Camper and Parent/Guardian also agree to release and discharge the Ukrainian Catholic Eparchy, its employees/servants as well as the Camp owners from all liability, claims and courses of action of whatever nature arising from the Camp.

Parents/Guardians of any Camper found willfully abusing or damaging the Camp will be liable for paying the damages in full. In addition, the Campers who are found responsible for willful damage will not be allowed to attend this Camp in the future.

Parents, be aware that Campers are **NOT allowed to make or receive any phone calls** home or elsewhere during their week at camp. Cell phones are not permitted.

The Camp Administration is not responsible for items that are lost or stolen during camp. *Please mark all clothing and other personal articles with the camper's full name!*
