Papal Bull



Benedictus episcopus servus servorum Dei

Greetings and Apostolic Blessing to our beloved son, Kenneth Nowakowski, member of the clergy of the Eparchy of Saskatoon for the Ukrainians and Chancellor of its Curia, the Bishop-elect of the Eparchial See of New Westminster for the Ukrainians. Wherewith, like Blessed Peter we have accepted a very grave solicitude for the welfare of all the flock of the Lord, everyday, with all solicitude, with the help of God, we are striving for the good of the particular churches. Therefore, when a Bishop for the vacant Eparchy of New Westminster for the Ukrainians was to be elected, because of the resignation of your predecessor the Venerable Brother Severian Stephan Yakymyshyn, OSBM was made according the norm of the Code of Canons of the Eastern Churches - Canon 210 §1, we have considered you, dear son, to be gifted with bright intellectual endowments and experienced in pastoral and philosophical sciences, to be capable to administer it. Hence upon the advice of our venerable Brother-Cardinal of the Holy Church of Rome the Prefect of the Congregation of the Eastern Churches, having the Apostolic authority we nominate you the Bishop of the Eparchy of New Westminster for the Ukrainians, with all the rights and duties proper to this office. As to your Episcopal ordination make your profession of the Faith and oath of obedience towards us and our Successors, observing the norms of the established Code. We also urge that these letters be made public to your clergy and people; whom we urge to gladly accept you, and to be always united with you. And, in the end, beloved son, through the intercession of the Virgin Mary, with the perpetual song of the Apostles (cfr. The Hymn of the Akatistos, 7), we pray for the gifts of the Holy Spirit, with Whose help, you will be able to pasture your flock, especially with charity, the distinguished virtue of pastors: for we guide inasmuch as we love. May the light and the peace of Christ be with you always and with the ecclesial communities of this Eparchy so dear to us. Given in Rome, at St. Peter's, this first day of the month of June, in the year of the Lord, two thousand and seven, the third year of our Pontificate.

Для мене особисто є великою втратою те, що я не можу взяти участі в хіротонії Владика Кенета і сповнити свого обов'язку - впровадити його на престол Нью-Вестмінстерської єпархії в Західній Канаді. Такою, видно, є Божа воля, але я хочу бути з усіма вами в молитві, подяці Господеві за те, що Він робить для нашої Церкви й народу.

Сьогоднішня подія для мене має два символічні аспекти: один, що стосується цілої нашої Церкви, другий - особи новопоставлениго Владика.

Нью-Вестмінстерська єпархія найдалше віддалена від України, від тієї країни, з якої вже понад сто років тому на канадську землю приходили перші емігранти з України. І хоч я говорю про втрату для себе, про те, що не можу радіти вповні, сьогодні радіє ціла наша Церква, розтягнута по земній кулі на кілометри й милі, а проте - єдина. І власне сьогоднішній день і подія - чин хіротонії Єпископа Нью-Вестмінстерської спархії Кенета - є найкращим доказом цього, бо сьогодні ми особливо відчуваємо ту єдність нашої Церкви. І хоч я нині далеко від Вас, а почувуюсь немовби був разом із вами. Єдність Церкви, незалежно від того, де кожний із нас народився, є надзвичайно важливою, бо це не тільки зовнішня спільність, вияв певної приналежності - це зміст святої віри, якої свідком і вчителькою виступає паша свята Церква. Так дав Господь, що ми розійшлися по цілому світові, по різних континентах, річних країнах, але ми маємо одну і ту саму святу віру і передаємо її в одній і тій

самій традиції. Значить кожний із нас, де б пін не був, де б не жив, яке б не було його заняття і особиста місія, кожен із нас має той самий духовний корінь, скарб, який свята Церква дала йому на дорогу життя. Мн повинні надзвичайно дорожити цим, бо це не є щось принагідне чи випадкове, це те, що робить наше життя важливим і цінним, що робить його нашим шляхом до Небесного Царства. Віддаль, отже, не перешкоджає нашій єдності, і це надзвичайно важливий момент сьогоднішньою свята, бо в Канаді, як і в Україні, ми потребуємо Бога, Божої науки, ми потребуємо Святих Божих тайн, мн потребуємо проводу в нашому щоденному жиггі.

Другий символічний аспект сьогодні шнього свята - особа ново поставленого Владика, Він народився в Канаді, виховувався тут, але служив в різних місцевостях і поза межами цієї країни. Своє сніаціениче служіння він сповняв на канадській землі, в Римі як близький співробітник святої пам'яті Блаженнішого Мирослава Івана Любачівського; він служив також і в Україні, продовжуючи співпрацю ч Блаженніш й м Мирославом Іваном, помагаючи також і мені, працюючи для нашої Церкви й спільноти. Канада впродовж років видала багатьох церковних діячів, які працювали і сьогодні працюють ;іля нашої Церкви; це єпископи, священники, миряни. Вони працюють, незважаючи на те, що віддалені від землі, де народилися. Живим прикладом цього є власне новопоставлений Владика Кеєт. І коли ми сьогодні вітаємо його, то цим хочемо підкреслити природу Української Греко-Католицької Церкви, яка однакова і одна в різних країнах: ми хочемо підкреслити і заслугу вірних нашої Церкви на канадській землі, які зуміли поєднати своє походження із своїм покликанням, вийти за межі однієї країни, розуміючи, що наша Церква не має границь.

Дорогий Владико Кенете, сердечне вітаю Вас і дякую Вам, за все, що Ви зробили для моїх попередників і для мене під час свого священничого служіння, за те, що Ви зробили для вірних нашої Церкви, для всіх, хто потребував Вашої допомоги. Продовжуйте цю працю, а я вимолюватиму для Вас у Господа всіх потрібних Вам благодатей. Працюйте па слану Вожу на зем.Іі Вашого походження, як Ви робили це в Україні чи Італію Серлечно вітаю Вас І передаю Вам своє благословення.

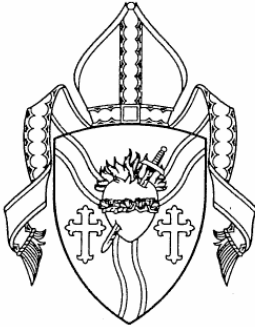

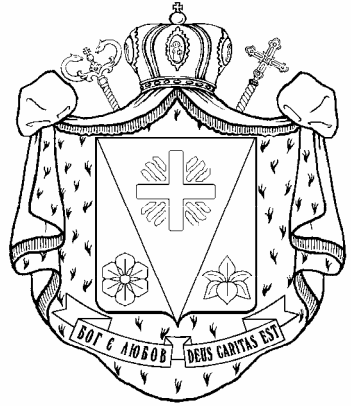


Our New Bishop and Our Eparchy

Coat-of-Arms

Bishop Ken Nowakowski's coat of arms is composed of a shield with its charges (symbols), a motto scroll, and external ornamentation.

The shield contains three triangular fields: a blue "V" descending from the top of the shield, flanked by a red field on the viewer's left and a gold field on the right.



The cross with rays is the emblem of the Caritas organizations; its blue and gold colors are symbolic of the Bishop's Ukrainian heritage and his service as President of Caritas Ukraine. The white and gold colours represent the Roman Apostolic See which Bishop Nowakowski and the Eparchy of New Westminster are united to. The white and red represent the Canadian national colours. The dogwood blossom is the floral emblem of British Columbia, where the Eparchial See of New Westminster is located. The Western Red Lily is the floral emblem of Saskatchewan, where the Bishop was born; the gold field is taken from the provincial flag of Saskatchewan.

The shield is placed on a purple episcopal mantle edged in ermine fur, crowned by a bishop's gold mitre with red lining. The coat of arms is completed with external ornaments: a gold bishop's crozier and cross, placed in back of the mantle.

The blue ribbon, placed below the shield, displays Bishop Nowakowski's motto in Ukrainian and Latin: God is Love. These words are taken from the Letter of St. John the Apostle, which summarizes the core of the Christian faith and the basis for all Christian action. Written in Ukrainian and Latin, the motto is meant to

show the eucharistic communion the Ukrainian Catholic Church shares with the Holy See in Rome. This was also the motto of the second Eparchy of New Westminster, Bishop Severian Yakymyshyn, OSBM, as well as the title of the first Apostolic Letter of His Holiness Benedict XVI: *Deus Caritas Est*.

The coat of arms was designed by Andriy Grechylo, President of the Ukrainian Heraldic Society; Lviv, Ukraine.

Curriculum Vitae of the Most Rev. Ken Nowakowski

Rev. Kenneth Nowakowski, was born on May 16, 1958, in North Battleford, Saskatchewan, the second of three sons of Stanley and Roma (nee Ryhorchuk). He attended elementary school in Battleford and high school in North Battleford.

Fr. Nowakowski held several secular positions in the private and government sector prior to entering the formation program at the Redeemer House of Studies in Toronto, graduating from St. Michael's College, University of Toronto in 1984 with a Bachelor of Religious Studies and Philosophy. He was sent to St. Josaphat's Ukrainian Catholic Pontifical College in Rome and received his Bachelor of Sacred Theology from the Pontifical University of St. Thomas Aquinas in 1989. He was ordained a priest by Bishop Basil Filevich, of blessed memory for the Ukrainian Catholic Eparchy of Saskatoon on August 19, 1989, in St. George's Cathedral in Saskatoon.

Fr. Nowakowski returned to Rome the autumn of 1989 for further studies in Eastern Canon Law. In response to a growing refugee presence in Italy, Fr. Nowakowski founded and directed the Ukrainian Catholic Refugee Office. In June of 1990 he was appointed vice chancellor and chief of staff to His Beatitude Myroslav Ivan Cardinal Lubachivsky, Father and Head of the Ukrainian Catholic Church and Major Archbishop of Lviv of the Ukrainians.

In July of 1991, His Beatitude Myroslav Ivan ended his exile, returned to his Archiepiscopal See in Lviv, Ukraine, and appointed Fr.

Nowakowski his chief of staff in Lviv. Fr. Nowakowski held that position until 1995. He also served as vice-rector of Holy Spirit Seminary in Lviv 1991-1992. In 1994 he was instrumental in founding the Ukrainian Catholic Church's official charitable organization, Caritas Ukraine, and was its president until 2001. As president of Caritas Ukraine he oversaw its charitable works, including the Metropolitan Andrew Sheptytsky Hospital, the development of home-care projects, and the establishment of the eparchial branches of Caritas Ukraine.

During the visit of His Holiness John Paul II to Ukraine in June 2001, Fr. Nowakowski was the Director of the Press Office of the Catholic Churches in Ukraine.

Fr. Nowakowski was appointed rector of Holy Spirit Ukrainian Catholic Seminary in Ottawa in November 2001. In October 2002 he was also appointed Press Officer/Spokesperson of the Ukrainian Catholic Church in Canada. During the 2002 World Youth Day in Canada he served as the Vatican Accredited Media Personnel Liaison and Assistant to Mr. Vic van Brantagem of the Press Office of the Holy See. During his tenure as rector he provided pastoral assistance to his own Eparchy of Saskatoon as well as other Ukrainian Catholic Eparchies in Canada in the summer months.

Fr. Nowakowski is a member of the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops' Committee on Adult Catechesis.

In July of 2006, Fr. Nowakowski was appointed Chancellor of the Ukrainian Catholic Eparchy of Saskatoon.

The Ukrainian Catholic Church

The Eparchy of New Westminster is one of five ecclesiastical territories for Ukrainian Catholics in Canada, which include Winnipeg (the Metropolitan See), Toronto and Eastern Canada, Saskatoon and Edmonton. The Ukrainian Catholic Church in Canada shares a particular historical and ecclesial bond with the Ukrainian Catholic

Church in Ukraine and throughout the world. The Bishop of New Westminster is a member of the Synod of Bishops of the Ukrainian Catholic Church under the leadership of His Beatitude, Lubomyr Cardinal Husar, Major Bishop of Kyiv-Halych, “Father and Head” for Ukrainian Catholics worldwide.’

The Ukrainian Catholic Church is, of course, in full Eucharistic communion with the Roman Apostolic See under the leadership of His Holiness Pope Benedict XVI and, as such, is part of the Universal Catholic Church. It is one of about two dozen particular or “sui iuris” (autonomous) Eastern Catholic Churches, with its own hierarchy, liturgical rite, common and

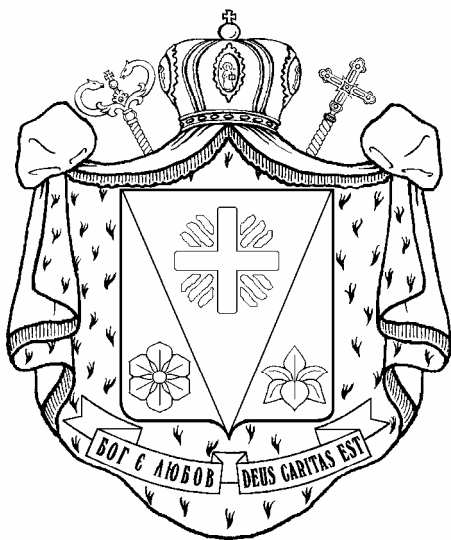


Bishop-elect Nowakowski meets in Ottawa with His Eminence Luigi Ventura Apostolic Nuncio in Canada.

particular canon law, spiritual and theological heritage. The One, Holy, Catholic, and Apostolic Church is fully present in these particular Churches, sharing an equal dignity and a fullness of faith and sacramental life. The Ukrainian Catholic Church is the largest Eastern Catholic Church in the world and the second largest Church in the Catholic communion in Canada.

Sharing the same basic Christian faith with the Roman Catholic Church, the Ukrainian Catholic Church expresses its faith differently, following the liturgical, spiritual, iconographic and theological tradition of the Byzantine Church of Constantinople, from which Ukraine received the Christian faith in 988. Separated from the Catholic communion in 1054, it reestablished unity with the Roman Apostolic See in 1596, in the so-called "Union of Brest". As a Catholic Church of the Eastern tradition, the Ukrainian Catholic Church has a particular ecumenical commitment to work towards the “reconciliation of the two 'lungs,' East and West,” as His Holiness Benedict XVI expressed recently. Thus the Ukrainian Catholic Church, sharing as it does essentially the same heritage of theology, liturgy, spirituality,

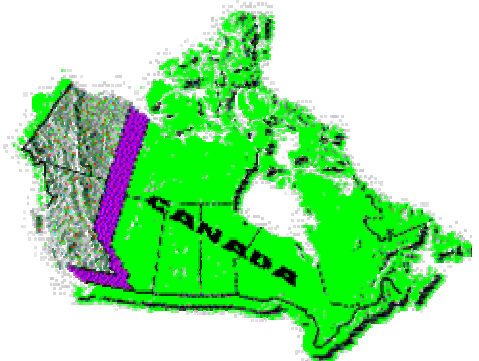

way of life and in large measure, essentially the same faith with it's Sister Church, the Ukrainian Orthodox Church, has that special call to work and pray for the day when all will be truly 'one in Christ. The Ukrainian Catholic Church can be best described in the words of the late Pope John Paul II: "Orthodox in faith and Catholic in love".

History of the New Westminster Eparchy

The Ukrainian Catholic Eparchy of New Westminster was created by the Apostolic See in Rome on June 24, 1974. Formerly part of the Edmonton Eparchy, the territory of our Eparchy is comprised of British Columbia, the Yukon Territory and the Northwest Territories west of the 120th longitude.



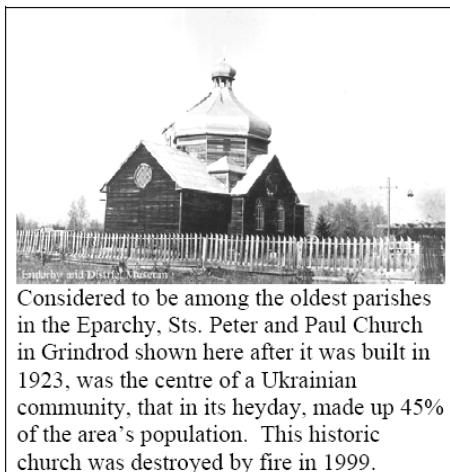
The first bishop appointed was Most Rev. Jerome Chimy, OSBM. His Episcopal ordination took place on September 5, 1974 at St. Mary's Ukrainian Catholic Church, and his enthronement was on the following day at Holy Eucharist Parish, which he named as his cathedral.

During his episcopate the Eparchial Chancery and Residence were completed in 1976. One of Bishop Jerome's first important tasks was to see that each parish was well staffed with a good priest. His zeal for fostering priestly and religious vocations was very notable and some of those drawn by this zeal are still serving as priests in the Eparchy to this day. The Sisters Servants of Mary Immaculate were also established in the Eparchy during this time to work with the youth, reach out with a Catechesis program throughout the Eparchy, and assist in general with Eparchial administration. Annunciation House for the sisters was established in 1982. Bishop Jerome was actively involved in the early organizational life in the Eparchy, including the establishment Ukrainian Catholic Brotherhood, Ukrainian Catholic

Woman's League of Canada and the Ukrainian Catholic Youth of Canada. Among many notable accomplishment, he provided highly effective leadership in commemorating celebrations of the Millennium of Ukrainian Christianity in 1988. Bishop Jerome was so well known for his missionary and pastoral zeal, his warm and friendly personality that almost all of the laity in the Eparchy knew him personally. He was deeply loved and respected by all. His Excellency Bishop Jerome passed into eternity on September 19, 1992.

Bishop Chimy was succeeded by the Most Rev. Severian Yakymyshyn, OSBM. The second Bishop of the Eparchy had his Episcopal ordination on March 25, 1995, at St. Mary's Church in Vancouver. During the interim for two and a half years the Eparchy was served by Very Reverend Kenneth Olsen as its administrator.

To preserve the history of the Ukrainian Catholic Eparchy Bishop Severian Yakymyshyn, OSBM commissioned the publication of the monumental book (432 pages) that was authorized by the late Bishop Jerome Chimy, OSBM and was compiled and edited by the late Professor Michael Tatarniuk. To continue the keeping of the story of the Eparchy more up to date Bishop Severian commissioned the preparation of an Official Eparchial Web Site.



To coordinate the administration of the parishes Bishop Severian published and made available to all the "Parish Constitution" so that all the parishes, their pastors, councils, committees and parishioners would abide by the same norms.

To safeguard the properties and liabilities of the parishes the Bishop authorized that all would be insured under the same umbrella insurance with better premium costs and coverage.

To secure the presence of resident pastors in the parishes, so that there could be Divine Liturgies on every Sunday and Holy Days of Obligation, the bishop brought a number of priests from Ukraine. With the Finance Committee he coordinated for better equitable salaries, medical insurances, pension plans and life insurances for the pastors of the Eparchy. He organized and the Eparchy sponsored the annual spiritual retreats for the priests of the Eparchy. With much assistance from the Sisters Servants of Mary Immaculate – Ambrose and Ruth, he continued to support the Youth and Children’s St. Volodymyr Camp programs in the Eparchy. And to help with the funding for the poorer parishes and the levees of the Eparchy (funding of the Synods and Sobors of the Ukrainian Catholic Church, Canonization of Ukrainian Saints, Seminarians and Seminary, St. Peter’s and St. Andrew’s Pence, etc.), a program “Project Hope” was brought into practice, which now has become the “Parish Assessment Program.”

Thus, with the great cooperation of the faithful and their generous contributions, the Eparchy was able to continue its missionary ministry throughout the vast, beautiful province of British Columbia.

With Bishop Severian Yakymyshyn, OSBM reaching the age for a bishop’s retirement, the Holy Father – Pope Benedict XVI appointed a new bishop for this Eparchy in a younger man – Bishop Ken Nowakowski, who takes over the office on the day of his ordination and installation on July 24, 2007.

We are witnessing the start of a new chapter in the history of our Eparchy.

Pope John Paul II about the Eastern and Latin Rites

On May 2, 1995, Pope John Paul II promulgated his Apostolic Letter *Oriente Lumen - The Light of the East*, calling all members of the

Catholic Church to an increased awareness of the rich spiritual traditions of the Eastern Catholic Churches. His Holiness said:

“Since, in fact, we believe that the venerable and ancient tradition of the Eastern Churches is an integral part of the heritage of Christ’s Church, the first need for Catholics is to be familiar with that tradition, so as to be nourished by it and to encourage the process of unity in the best way possible for each.”

In his 1999 Apostolic Exhortation *Ecclesia in America - The Church in America*, Pope John Paul II called all members of the Catholic Church to a new evangelization. The Pontiff stated:

“In this spirit of communion, it is worth considering ... that catechesis and theological formation for lay people and seminarians of the Latin Church include knowledge of the living tradition of the Christian East; that the Bishops of the Eastern Catholic Churches participate in the Latin Episcopal Conferences of the different countries. This fraternal cooperation, while offering valuable help to the Eastern Churches of recent foundation in America [and Canada], will certainly also enrich the particular Churches of the Latin rite with the spiritual heritage of the Eastern Christian tradition.”

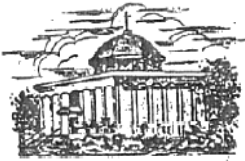
